

The South Newton Township (SNT) Board of Supervisors (BOS) met at the South Newton Township Building, 11High Mountain Road, Shippensburg, PA. Chairman David **Durff** called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the pledge of allegiance. Board members present were Chairman David **Durff**, Supervisor Glenn **Keefer**, Supervisor Leroy **Bowermaster**, and Solicitor Marcus **McKnight**.

➤ **DELINQUENT GARBAGE COLLECTION ACCOUNTS –**

Supervisor Glenn KEEFER motioned to have Solicitor McKnight file complaint against Henry Thissen, having Chairman David DURFF sign complaint. Supervisor Leroy BOWERMASTER seconded, motion carried. Fines will be up to \$1,360.00.

Solicitor McKnight stated that Mr. Walls received an inspection from MDIA. Chairman Durff reported that JWP has not had any contact with Mr. Walls regarding the pumping of his septic or a new system. Solicitor McKnight was instructed to move forward.

Solicitor McKnight stated he will file again and ask for a daily fine and notification must be made when tank is pumped. Mr. Walls also needs to lock in with a contractor.

Chairman Durff inquired as to when Schneider's Sheriff Sale was going to be held. Solicitor McKnight stated he would look into it.

Solicitor McKnight stated that if Mr. Bixler wants the Ag. Security, he will need to follow through.

16. SUPERVISORS COMMENTS –

Chairman Durff stated he spoke to the Dog Warden regarding the incident at 22 Maple Avenue. The PSP has filed charges, they plead guilty, and was charged with an aggressive dog. Once the Dog Warden serves papers, they have 30 days to euthanasia or pay \$500.00 fine. The dogs were vaccinated.

Chairman Durff and Supervisor Bowermaster visited the Kole property on High Mountain Road regarding the water situation.

Chairman Durff inquired to Chief Burkett the status of the radios. Chief stated they are still waiting on County to do programming.

Chairman Durff stated he has a call into the Historical sign person.

The 81 gate is not functioning correctly. Supervisor Keefer will look into this.

Chairman Durff stated that he received a call from Mr. Baum, 114 Water Street, regarding the water run off from 81 bridge. Chairman and PennDot will look at the situation.

Resolution 215-03, Emergency Operations Plan was presented and approved on a ***Chairman David DURFF motion, seconded by Supervisor Glenn KEEFER, motion carried.***

Three bids were received for replacement of the roof on township building. After reviewed all three bids, ***Chairman David DURFF motioned to accept the bid from Cumberland Poultry and Construction, with the 6” insulation and if the spouting needs replaced, proceed. This was seconded by Supervisor Leroy BOWERMASTER, motion carried.***

Chairman Durff stated the Road Bid announcement is out and are due back on 7/21/2015, with completion of work by 9/24/2015. Chairman Durff met with Rick Levan, Municipal Services, PennDot to review the roads and bid information prior to advertising.
