Chairman Durff stated the received a call regarding the telephone pole on the corner of 174 and Hammond Road. Tractor Trailers are catching the pole, and the owner is afraid the pole will fall onto house. Linda Collins, Shetron Auction & Equipment stated that Mrs. Cressler called her as well, and Terry Shetron has agreed to foot the bill of moving the pole, if PPL decides it is not their issue.
