

The South Newton Township (SNT) Board of Supervisors (BOS) met at the South Newton Township Building, 11 High Mountain Road, Shippensburg, PA. Chairman David **Durff** called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the pledge of allegiance. *Chairman DURFF motioned to donate \$1,000.00 to the Parade Committee, Supervisor Glenn KEEFER seconded, motion carried.*

*Supervisor Glenn KEEFER motioned to approve transportation and seminar costs for the Chairman and Secretary/Treasurer to attend the Annual PSATS Conference in Hershey, PA, Supervisor Leroy BOWERMASTER seconded, motion carried.*

*Chairman DURFF motioned to replace the nubs on the Trackless Mower thru Rick's Repair, Supervisor Leroy BOWERMASTER seconded, motion carried.*

*Chairman DURFF motioned to have the Solicitor prepare a Resolution for the next meeting, which will authorize the Solicitor to automatically send letters to delinquent trash accounts, without the need to discuss at every meeting, Supervisor Glenn KEEFER seconded, motion carried.*

Chairman Durff inquired to Zoning Officer if Mr. Thissen has applied for a permit as of this date. Zoning Officer stated he has not. Solicitor McKnight stated that we will need to wait the full 30 days from the hearing before proceeding.

Chairman Durff inquired to Zoning Officer if Snoke's Excavating applied for a permit for the new salt shed. Zoning Officer stated they had not. Chairman Durff requested the Zoning Officer contact Snoke's regarding a permit.
